(Term - Spring One)



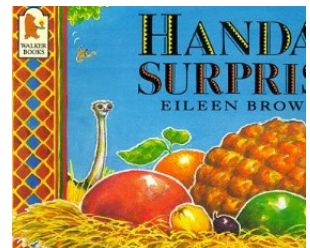
This Term. . .

Our topics for this half term are seasons/weather and African animals. We will start the term by looking at the different seasons and types of weather focusing on similarities, differences, patterns and change. We will then move onto learning about African animals and comparing them to animals in our own environment.

During these topics our story focuses are 'Skip through the seasons', 'William's winter wish', and 'We're going on a bear hunt' and 'Handa's Surprise'.

We have now placed the children into specific phonics groups matching their phonics knowledge. They have really settled and responded well to this approach. Children will receive a book that matches their phonics level.

In maths we will be focusing on counting and writing numbers to 20, more and fewer, ordering and sequencing familiar events, 3D shapes, addition and subtraction.
