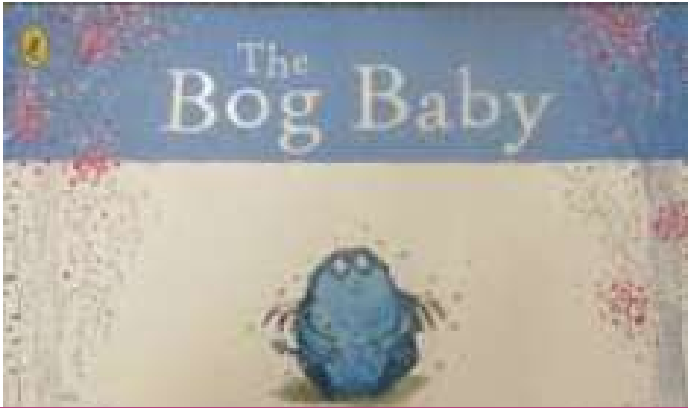


Year 1: Why are humans not like tigers?

Cheetahs are the world's fastest land animal.



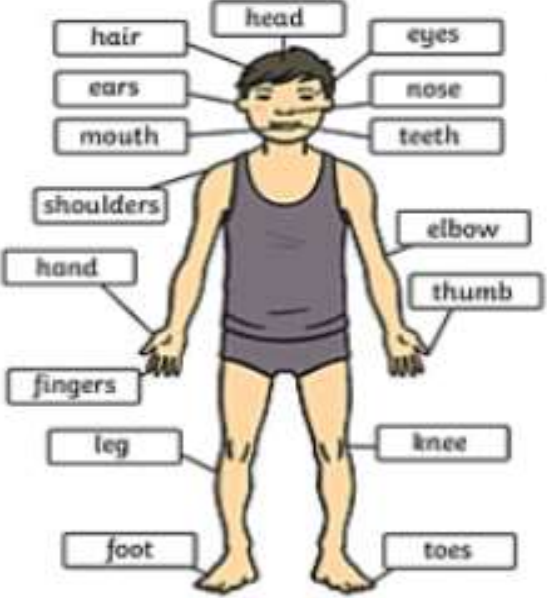
Would we call a Bog Baby a wild animal?
