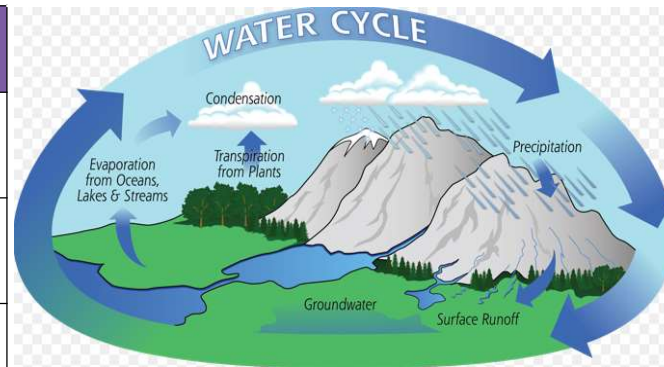


Water Aid: Year 6 Knowledge Organiser

Subject Specific Vocabulary	
Guinea Worm	A parasite that feeds off another living creature to survive.
Hygiene	Keeping clean to maintain good health and prevent disease
Non government organisation	A non government, voluntary group that works to support others.
Campaign	An organised cause of action to achieve a goal.
Lines of latitude and longitude	Lines that located points on the Earth's surface, around the equator.
Sanitation	Health conditions that include the use of water, soap and toilets.
Challenging advocacy	Campaigning and influencing decisions about the environment
